



# INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETION OF HUNT WAIVER PACKAGES

March 26, 2009

There are three new forms to be signed by all riders participating in activities organized by or originating on the grounds of Waterloo Hunt.

- Waiver, Agreement & Liability Release (for all riders, all spouses and all parents to sign)
- Disclosure of Risks Involved in Equine Activities (for minors and one/either parent to sign)
- Safety Helmet & Protective Headgear Statement (for all adult riders and for minors/one parent to sign)

***NOTE: SPOUSAL and SECOND PARENT SIGNATURES ARE REQUIRED ONLY ON THE WAIVER AS THIS IS THE PRIMARY CONTRACT WITH THE CLUB MADE ON BEHALF OF EACH RIDER.***

*(Sorry that the page numbers on the Waiver were dropped in footer formatting, but there are 5 pages in the Waiver, Agreement & Liability Release, and we refer to those page numbers below.)*

## **IF YOU ARE AN UNMARRIED ADULT....**

Execute the Waiver by:

- 1) Printing your name, address and contact information on page 1
- 2) Initial at paragraphs 4, 5 and 6.
- 3) Complete paragraph 10 indicating who should be contacted in event you are injured.
- 4) Complete the check box and initial each representation at paragraph 12.
- 5) When you have read the entire agreement, sign on Page 5 as contracting party, print your name beneath your signature and enter the date you have signed.

Complete and sign the Safety Helmet and Protective Headgear Statement.  
Return to the Hunt Secretary.

## **IF YOU ARE A MARRIED ADULT....**

Execute the Waiver by:

- 1) Printing your name, address and contact information on page 1
- 2) Printing your spouse's name on page 1 as an additional contracting party
- 3) BOTH SPOUSES should initial at paragraphs 4, 5 and 6.
- 4) Complete paragraph 10 indicating who should be contacted in the event you are injured.
- 5) The Rider/Contracting Party should complete the check boxes and initial the representations at paragraph 12.
- 6) When you and your spouse have read the entire agreement, BOTH SPOUSES should sign on Page 5 as Rider/Contracting Party and Additional Contracting Party. Please print your names below your signatures, and enter the date you have signed.

Complete and sign the Safety Helmet and Protective Headgear Statement.  
Return to the Hunt Secretary.

### **IF YOU ARE A FOXHUNTING FAMILY WITH CHILDREN...**

Releases for children who foxhunt may be executed by adding their names to the waiver of either parent. If both parents ride, either waiver may be used for this purpose. Simply print the child's name and date of birth on page 1. If additional spaces are needed they may be handwritten onto the form.

Be sure to complete and sign the boxed section on page 2 pertaining to foxhunting. BOTH parents must sign here, and the name of a grandparent must be entered if a grandparent is permitted to substitute for you.

If the family prefers, a separate release may be executed for all children. This may be preferred if there are parents who must sign who are not in the household.

If preparing a separate waiver for the family's children, the Waiver will be executed on behalf of the child by a parent who will :

- 1) Print the name of EITHER PARENT as contracting party.
- 2) Print the name of the other parent of this child as an additional contracting party.
- 3) Complete contact information on page 1.
- 4) List the names/dates of birth of all children covered by the Waiver, adding new spaces as needed.
- 5) Enter both parents' signatures in the boxed section re: Foxhunting Activities and designate a grandparent if desired.
- 6) Enter both parents' initials at paragraphs 4, 5 and 6.
- 7) Complete emergency contact information at paragraph 10.
- 8) Both parents should complete the check boxes and initial at the representations of paragraph 12.
- 9) It is not required that the child rider sign this form, but signatures of both parents are required.

EACH CHILD and EITHER PARENT must also sign and date the

- Safety Helmet & Protective Headgear Statement
- Disclosure of Risks Involved in Equine Activities (For Minors Only)
